Transition into Y1 learning

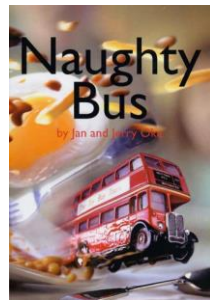
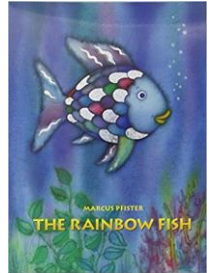
- We will run an EYFS based curriculum at the beginning of Autumn 1.

Ready to learn

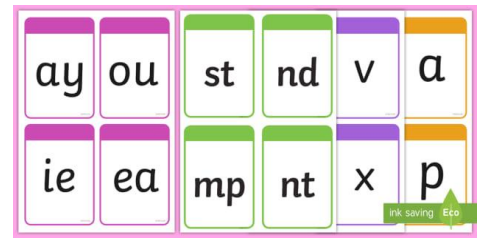
Ready to learn > time to make a choice > time to reflect

Phonics



In year 1, we place huge emphasis on becoming a fluent decoder as this enables our learners to become successful readers.

The children will receive daily phonics teaching as a whole class or in small groups.

Their phonic knowledge is tested in the Summer term with the statutory phonic screener.

Phonics Screener

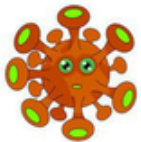
The children will read 20 real words and 20 'alien' words using their phonics to decode.

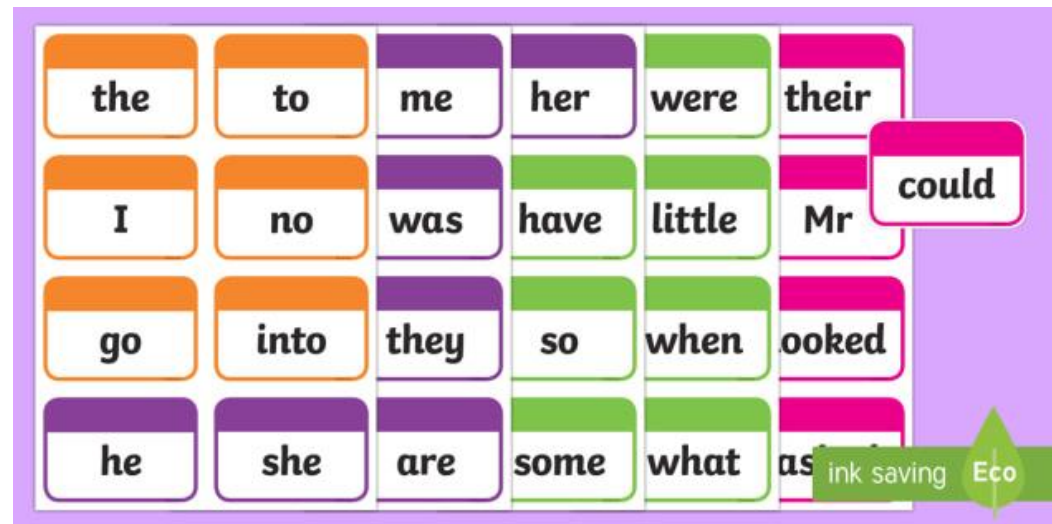
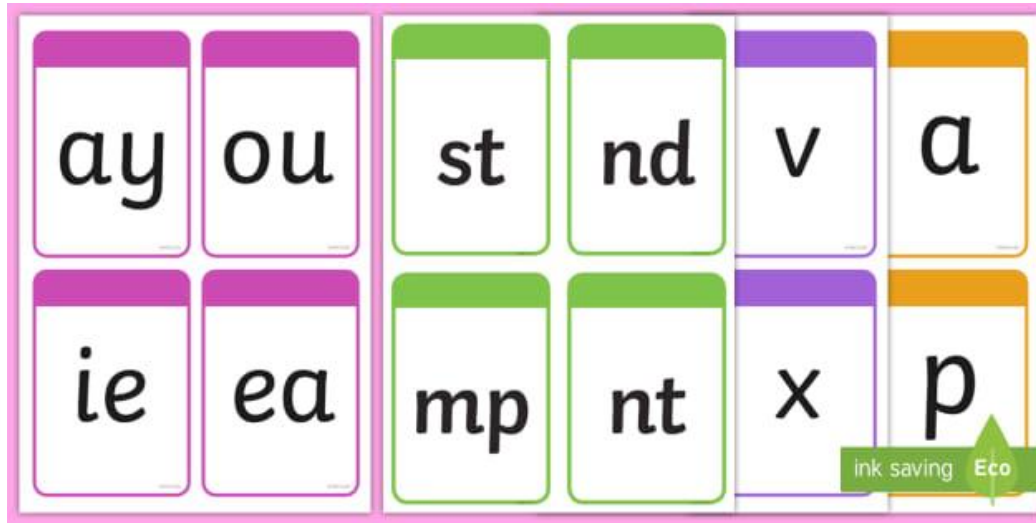
There will be 2 information sessions about the Year 1 Phonics Screener.
